A **Talented Student** within the framework of the Ministry of Health is defined as a student who demonstrates outstanding academic performance, exceptional research capability, creativity, or significant achievements in scientific, educational, or technological fields related to medical and paramedical sciences. Such students are identified based on specific criteria, including a high-grade point average, publication of articles in reputable scientific journals, participation in approved research projects, registration of inventions, or distinguished performance in national or international scientific competitions during their academic studies.



Achieving the status of a Talented Student offers numerous advantages, including access to special educational facilities and incentives such as research grants, priority participation in advanced training programs, facilitated admission to higher academic levels, and structured academic mentorship. Moreover, this recognition strengthens the student's academic and professional profile, expands opportunities for national and international collaboration, and contributes significantly to accelerated academic growth and future career development in the fields of medical and paramedical sciences.

The Office of Talented Students at the School of Paramedical Sciences is directed by Mr. Ali Sadeghi Varzaghan, faculty member of the Department of Anesthesia. The Head of the Office is

responsible for implementing policies, planning academic and research support programs, and supervising activities related to talented and high-achieving students, in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Health.

Eligibility Criteria for Recognition as a Talented Student

Students may be recognized as Talented Students if they meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Ranking below 500 in the National Entrance Examination for Experimental Sciences
- Holding a medal in the National Student Olympiad (high school level)
- Holding a medal in an Individual Student Olympiad (university level)
- Achieving first place in a Group Student Olympiad
- Recipients of top ranks or awards in Razi, Khwarizmi, or Isar Festivals

- **Holding a registered patent relevant to the field of study**
- **Selected as a National Exemplary (Outstanding) Student**
- **Ranking within the top 2.5% in comprehensive national examinations**
- **Top performers in MSc and PhD entrance or qualifying examinations**
- **Ranking within the top 10% of each entry cohort based on cumulative GPA**
- **Ranking within the top 1% of each entry cohort based on cumulative GPA**
- **Recognized as an Outstanding Researcher (Research Track)**
